This is your Friday afternoon update for the 200\400 block of N Washington streetscape project.

Current work for the past week:

- All brick pavers have been installed and sanding and levelling will begin next week
- Finished saw cutting of the asphalt on the 400 block to prepare for removal of the curb and gutter
- Completed asphalt patching along new curb and gutter on the 300 block

Look ahead next week:

- Sanding and levelling of the brick pavers installed in the 300 block
- Starting concrete caulking on the 300 block
- Mobilization to the 400 block to begin later in the week to begin demolition

The 400 block will be closed once mobilization starts following the same time and procedures as the 300 block. A detour plan for the 400 block will be published on the City Facebook page and signage will be installed along 80 to direct all visitors and travelers to the 300 block.
