Upon approval of City Council at their December 2023 meeting, the Downtown Streetscaping Project continues this week with the 300/400 block of North Washington.

The results of this project will include:

- Upgrades to ADA ramps to make the sidewalks walking and wheelchair-friendly
- Installation of storm pipes/drains to keep water out of businesses during flooding
- Addition of appropriately-sized trees (maple?????) so roots won't grow into downtown businesses
- Create continuity of community appearance from the Courthouse to Highway 80

Intersections will be closed as work is being completed. This portion of the project is expected to be completed by May 2024.
